
DESIGN AT LARGE

For the 1st edition of Design Miami/ Paris, **GALERIE PATRICK SEGUIN** will present a 6×6 demountable house, designed by **JEAN PROUVÉ** in 1944.



In response to an order from the government, **JEAN PROUVÉ** began designing demountable temporary houses for those made homeless by the War in the East of France. Veritable "architectural feat", the 6×6 house was designed to be assembled on site in a day by only three people.

The frame, into which were inserted timber panels, was made in folded sheet steel, robust and lightweight. Left visible, the house's structural portal frames reveal all the ingenuity of the construction system designed by Jean Prouvé from 1938.

Founded in 1989, **GALERIE PATRICK SEGUIN** is located in Paris' Bastille district, in a 300m2 space designed by Jean Nouvel (Pritzker Prize 2008). The gallery has brought to light the talent of French designers such as **JEAN PROUVÉ**, **CHARLOTTE PERRIAND**, **PIERRE JEANNERET**, **LE CORBUSIER** and **JEAN ROYÈRE**.




