Galerie Patrick Seguin has been entrusted with the exclusive presentation of a collaboration between Saint Laurent, under the artistic direction of Anthony Vaccarello, and the estate of Charlotte Perriand that coincides with Art Basel/ Design Miami Paris. The exhibition presents an exceptional set of furniture pieces by Perriand designed between 1943 and 1967 – some never produced in her lifetime, others known only as prototypes or archival drawings. Selected by Vaccarello and edited by Saint Laurent in a strictly limited edition, each has been crafted with care, using refined materials and craftsmanship to remain true to Perriand's original vision.

Pieces on show include the *Banquette* (1967), designed for the Japanese Ambassador's residence in Paris; the *Bibliothèque Rio* (1962), made for Perriand's husband in Brazil; the *Table Mille-Feuilles* (1963), never realized in her lifetime due to its complexity; and the *Fauteuil Visiteur Indochine* (1943), recreated from a single surviving drawing. A reference to French modernism, Galerie Patrick Seguin now presents these pieces in Paris, offering fresh perspective and underlining their authorship, materiality and historical relevance. Together, they tell a wider story about French design, craftsmanship and the legacy of one of modernism's visionary women.
